




# What is Accreditation in LSI & GSI?

The Program is designed to introduce you to our model while actively practising personal change. We then focus on the technical aspects of the tools and effective learning frames for communicating live client data.


On successful completion of the Program, candidates are certified to use both the LSI and GSI diagnostics.

# Why Accreditation in LSI & GSI?


Developed 40 years ago, our model provides a way to measure and change the thinking and behavioural styles that drive the performance of both individuals and groups.

# How do I become Accredited?



## 1. PRE-WORK

The initial stage of the accreditation process, designed to ensure candidates meet the pre-requisites for the program.

## 2. FOUNDATIONS AND TECHNICAL WORKSHOPS

The next stage involves workshop and action learning components. Participants undertake 2 x 2 days of training (Foundations and Technical Workshops), and are then able to provisionally use and access the LSI and GSI.

## 3. RECALL WORKSHOP

The final stage of the Accreditation process where participants demonstrate their knowledge and experience to a peer group, in a one day assessment (Recall Workshop). Participants are required to successfully complete all three components in order to become Accredited.
